

## A Foe of "Humanity"

LONDON, Jan. 30 (AP)—Admiral Doenitz is said to exhort his crews to "kill, kill, kill! Have no humanity in your labors. Humanity means weakness," a British source quoted him as telling his men.

Transocean, a German news agency, said in a broadcast recorded by The Associated Press that Admiral Doenitz's appointment was of great importance because "the submarine has proved to be the sharpest weapon of German naval warfare. Even if Admiral Doenitz did not create the German submarine weapon, he has developed it to the extent that the tremendous success of the submarine warfare in the past is linked firmly with his name," the agency said.
