

HITLER CALLS IN DOENITZ

Talk With Admiral Is Laid to Decline in Allied Losses

BERNE, Switzerland, Dec. 15—

It was announced late tonight from Berlin that Adolf Hitler had "called in for consultation" his Navy chief, Grand Admiral Karl Doenitz, for a "discussion of the present U-boat warfare."

Recent German claims of sinkings in the Atlantic have dropped to such new lows that even the propaganda-ridden Berlin news-

paper readers have begun to comment on the drift of events, it was indicated. No communiqué will be issued after the meeting, the Berlin radio announced.
