

Ex-U-Boat Men Hear Doenitz

HAMBURG, Germany, Aug. 2 (Reuters) — Former Grand Admiral Karl Doenitz, leader of Nazi Germany after Hitler's death in April, 1945, was cheered today when he spoke at a reunion of 3,000 former U-boat officers and men. Admiral Doenitz, 67, who served a ten-year term in Spandau war crimes prison, told the men they could be proud of their service.
